

SCHSB Numbers




SCHSB Flock Numbers



2025 Accomplishments

- Launched the Water Trough Chats
- Co-hosted the 50th Year Celebration at the USU Shepherd's Symposium
- Continued work with the Genetics Project
- Added Classifieds to website
- Expanded our advertising efforts

Genetics Project Update

- Fifteen members submitted 93 samples from phenotypically diverse St Croix sheep.
- Analysis shows that St. Croix sheep cluster distinctly apart from other breeds
- University flocks were invited to submit samples as a pilot for registry readmittance.
- Utah State and Virginia State have each submitted 5 samples, which are being analyzed now.

- Test Genetics Project Re-Entry Process with University flocks
- Recruit at least one new Board member appointee
- Director Elections Dec 2026
